ABSTRACT

The ADEQ Pollution Complaints mobile app allows Arkansans to report environmental hazards in real time. The app is available at the App Store and Google Play Store. To file a complaint, users must provide a Complaint Type and a description of the potential violation. Users also need to provide the County, and the location or driving directions. Users will also be able to add photos of the potential hazard. Contact information may be provided, but it is not required. Complaints can be submitted anonymously. Users will be able to review all complaint information prior to submission. If users provides contact info, they will also receive an email confirming the complaint was sent. The major benefits of this app are to provide an accurate location of the violation and provide a portable tool for submitting a violation.







Point Us in the Right Direction


- Select your county and provide driving directions

- Photos you take within the ADEQ app will be geotagged with **GPS** coordinates if GPS location services are enabled on your mobile device.




- To receive follow up information, provide your contact info
