

## **EN Grants**

- **FY24 Award Cycle.** Some HQ assistance agreements from FY24 have not yet been awarded. Impacted (future) grantees were informed last week. EN grant staff will be working directly with these (future) grantees.
- FY25 Deadline Extended. The application deadline for the FY25 EN Grants was extended until at least Wednesday, April 30th, 2025 to allow for revisions in accordance with updated Agency priorities.

## **Virtual Exchange Service (VES)**

- Released in 2015
- What is it?
  - A centralized solution that replaces the need for Exchange
     Network (EN) partners to install and administer their own node.
- Purpose
  - Standardize and streamline sharing of regulatory data between EPA and partners.
- Complies with EN protocol
- Supports a subset of current EN dataflows

## **Recent Upgrades**

- Bringing VES into compliance with security mandates
  - o October 2024
    - Middleware Refactoring (Existing partners may be impacted)
    - TLS 1.0 and 1.1 Support Removal
    - Separated Test and Production environments
  - March 2025
    - Updated VES Connector to better support partners with specialized database environments, such as Oracle RAC, and streamline the flow of information between VES and the partnerhosted remote databases.



## **Challenges of using VES**

- VES connector installation for remote-hosted partners
- Supporting large data sets
- Historical VES services were configured incorrectly and caused data source connectivity issues
- XML Schema versions published to the Exchange Network (EN) that VES has not been updated to support
- Unsigned executable files
- Please reach out to CDX team for other alternatives/options if VES doesn't meet your business needs



### **VES Support**

#### EPA will continue to:

- Support VES administrative accounts
- Investigate VES logs and provide more details on errors reported by users
- Troubleshoot service configuration
- Provide support files and update when necessary
- Ensure our VES components are online and available
- Provisioning new VES partners and dataflows
- Verifying the reason for failure or pending transactions on the backend
- Maximum 5 hours to troubleshooting for the remote-hosted partners
- The maximum data transition we have seen is up to 175MB

#### **EPA will NOT**

- Develop new dataflow in VES
- Provide VES connector installation support for remote-hosted partners beyond our provided instructions
